

## **Supplemental Education Services – Frequently Asked Questions**

### **Who is eligible for FREE tutoring services?**

A: All students attending The Milwaukee Academy of Science may sign up for the free tutoring program known as Supplemental Education Services (SES).

### **When can I sign up for FREE tutoring services?**

A: Right now!

### **How do I apply for the Supplemental Services program?**

A: Call the school office at 414-933-0302 Ext. 5100 to schedule your SES meeting with the SES coordinator. This meeting will last approx. 10 minutes. If you have more than one child, an application must be filled out for each child.

### **Once I fill out the application, what do I do next?**

A: At this meeting, you will be given a list of providers. There are many different types of providers you can choose from. Each provider is different and offers a different type of service such as in-home or on-line tutoring. The SES coordinator will help you sort through the vendors. Once you select a vendor, the school sends the vendor a contract which they must accept and return in 15 days. If they accept our contract they will contact you to set up an initial evaluation meeting.

The school is not allowed to pick the vendor for you. You must meet with the SES team, review your options and make the selection.

### **I see that the vendors charge for their tutoring service. Who pays that fee?**

A: The Milwaukee Academy of Science. There is no cost to the family.

### **Can my child receive tutoring at The Milwaukee Academy of Science?**

A: No. Only vendors who have been approved by the Department of Public Instruction (DPI) can be selected. At this time, MAS does not have any teachers or programs that have been approved by the DPI. Many of our teachers do offer tutoring after school, but that is NOT part of the SES program.

**Will the school provided transportation to/from the tutoring location?**

No. Transportation is the responsibility of the family.

**What if I am not happy with the vendor I selected?**

You may not change vendors once you start the process. It is important that you have quality conversations with the company you selected before the tutoring process begins.
