Parent's Right to Ask

Dear Parent:

The Federal ESEA law requires us to inform you of your right to contact the academy principal and/or Human Resource Manager and request information about teacher qualifications. The law requires that this information be given to you in a timely manner. As a parent, you have the right to ask:

- Whether the teacher has met State qualification and licensing criteria for the grade levels and subject he/she is teaching
- Whether the teacher is teaching under emergency or other provisional status through which the State qualification were waived
- Whether the teacher is teaching in the field of discipline of their certification.

You may also ask whether your child receives help from a paraprofessional. If your child receives this assistance, we can provide you with information about the paraprofessional's qualifications.

Let me say that all teachers at Milwaukee Academy of Science have at least a bachelor's degree. Again, if you would like to see the state qualification for your child's teacher you may ask your child's academy principal, Human Resource Manager, or find it on the DPI website at:
