Grades Covered: K4-12th Grade

School Type: Independent Charter by the City of Milwaukee, established in 2000.

Educational Program

- MAS requires 24 credits to graduate.
- MAS requires twice the number of science credits to graduate High School than MPS & State requirements.
- Paraprofessional support in all K4-5th grade classroom.
- Inclusion Model for special education provides SPED services in the classroom.
- Social Emotional Literacy (SEL) curriculum in all K-8 Classrooms.
